2. Type in your 16-digit control number (located on the enclosed Notice) to log in.
3. Follow the simple instructions to vote online at [proxyvote.com/MGEE](https://proxyvote.com/MGEE).

# Frequently asked questions



## Why am I receiving this Notice of Internet Availability?

The Securities and Exchange Commission (“SEC”) permits companies to send the enclosed “Notice” instead of a full printed set of proxy materials. The Notice provides instructions on how to view proxy materials, vote online and request a full set of printed materials by mail. There are advantages to MGE Energy sending a Notice instead of a full set of materials, including lowering costs and reducing the environmental impact from printing and mailing full sets of proxy materials.

## How do I view the proxy materials online?

Go to [proxyvote.com/MGEE](https://proxyvote.com/MGEE), and enter your control number to get started. Your control number can be found on the enclosed Notice.

## How do I vote my shares?

You may vote online or by phone. The Notice provides instructions to vote online or to request a paper copy of the materials to vote by postal mail or by phone.

## What if I prefer to receive a paper copy of the proxy materials?

You can easily request a paper copy that will be mailed to you at no cost. Instructions on how to request a paper copy can be found in the *Get informed before you vote* section of the Notice.

## May I receive proxy materials for future meetings by email rather than receive a Notice?

Yes. Use your control number to log in at [proxyvote.com/MGEE](https://proxyvote.com/MGEE), and see the Delivery Settings section to sign up for electronic delivery.
